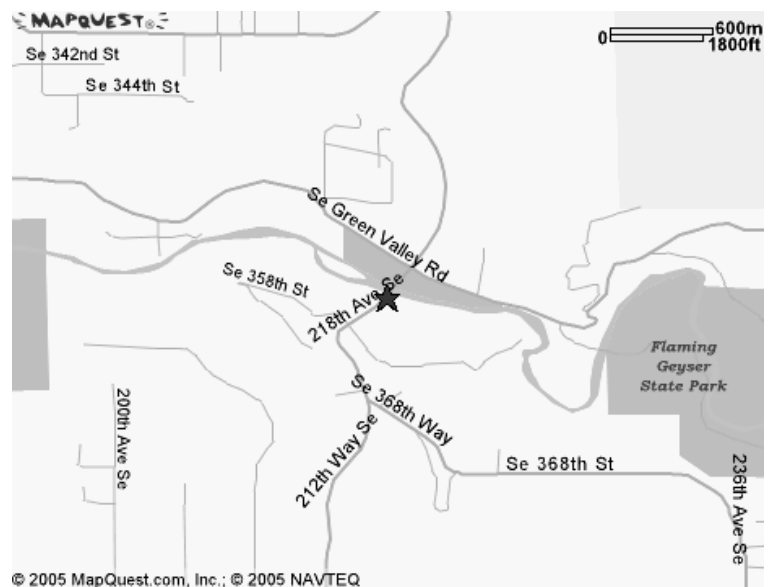
Entry Fees:	<p>For all dogs in the same household, entries received and paid for in the same transaction. Runs added at a later date start @ the \$12.00 level 1 to 5 runs=\$12.00 6 to 14 runs=\$ 11.00 15 to 28 runs=\$10.50 29+ runs=\$10.00 No Discounts for entries received after closing date. See entry form for post closing pricing.</p>
Refunds:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal, including, but not limited to, aggressive dogs. ◆ Handlers with medical emergencies providing a doctor's note or having an injured dog or bitch in heat, with veterinarian's documentation, may cancel 7 days prior to the start of the trial and receive a 50% credit slip. <p>* Due to the rising costs of trial production there will be a \$20 processing fee for cash (check) refund before closing though an exhibitor may choose to receive a credit slip for 100% of the refund value for no additional cost. Because of the high cost of credit card processing, any credit card refunds will incur a \$40.00 processing fee.</p>
Move-ups:	<p>Move-Ups will be allowed at this trial if received no later than 30 minutes after the last class on the previous day. There will be a Move-up sheet at the score table.</p>
Set up:	<p>No set up is permitted before 5:30 pm Thursday. Those who come out to help build rings, etc. will be allowed to set up as soon as the rings are built. Contact us at Info@AllDogsOnline.com if you would like to help set up.</p>
Judge's Briefing & Start Time:	<p>Judges' briefing begins each morning at approximately 7:30 am. First dog on the start line at 8 am.</p>
Awards:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Ribbons will be awarded for first thru fourth place in all jump heights of all divisions except for Chances which is a Q/no Q class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded for qualifying runs. <p>Please let us know if you may achieve a NATCH so that we have a ribbon for you too.</p>
Levels, Classes, Divisions, Categories:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Levels are Intro, Novice, Open and Elite, a dog may be in different levels throughout the trial. ◆ Classes are Regular, Jumpers, Chances, etc. ◆ Divisions are Standard, Veteran (Handler or Dog), Junior Handler (JH); a dog may not be entered in more than one division of the same class at a trial but may be in different divisions in different classes if handled by different people, i.e.: Standard Regular, JH Jumpers, or Veteran Handler Weavers. ◆ As of January-2014: Dogs must enter the Veterans Division after their 9th birthday. Dogs must enter the Skilled Category, Veterans Division after their 12th birthday. ◆ Categories are Proficient or Skilled, a dog is in one category for the duration of the trial. Skilled dogs MUST jump 4" lower than their Proficient height. Visit www.NADAC.com for further details
Measuring & Rules:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Visit http://www.nadac.com/Rules for NADAC trials.htm for complete NADAC rules, including measuring, height cards, jump heights, & exemptions ◆ NOTE: It is the exhibitor's responsibility to know and understand all rules as set forth by NADAC. For current information and discussions, please join www.NADACForum.com. This is an active, informative and lively group!
Non-Jumping Classes – Veteran or Disable Handler:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Handlers who are 60 years or older, or who have a disability that restricts mobility, may choose to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. This option is for Veteran/Disabled handlers in the non-jumping classes only. ◆ The Veteran/Disabled Handler division is designed for handlers who, due to age or impairment, are mobility limited and need extra time to guide their canine partners through an agility course. ◆ When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all dogs in all classes for the entire trial in this Division and must jump 4" lower than your Proficient, Standard Division jump height. In the non-jumping classes, dogs will be scored and placed with their Standard Division jump height.
Volunteers:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Breakfast and lunch items will be provided by the club for volunteer workers each day. We truly appreciate those who step into work on the day of the event as well.

<p>Confirmation & Results:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately. ◆ NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the www.NADACForum.com within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the Forum by going to www.NADACForum.com and submitting your request. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC. ◆ Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be recorded by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.
<p>Notice to Exhibitors:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ This trial is sanctioned by the North American Dog Agility Council (NADAC) with Zooming Agility Pups (ZAP) as host club. Exhibitors through a submission of an entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial. ◆ Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog. ◆ Any dog demonstrating aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside or outside of the ring, must be excused for the agility trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in enough control to perform all obstacles in a safe manner will be excused from the agility trial. ◆ No collars, leads, food, toys, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course entrance at any time. The only exception is leading your dog to the start on lead, and then handing the lead to a steward. ◆ Current Jump Height Tables, Breed Exemption List, description of classes, levels, and divisions are included in the current Exhibitors Handbook. ◆ Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog or handler is disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. ◆ Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging will be sent to the email address on the official entry form before the closing date and again one week before the trial. A paper confirmation letter will be sent to those without email. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary, Katrina Tustin, at Info@AllDogsOnline.com. ◆ Zooming Agility Pups, All Dogs Training Services, Argus Ranch, and/or NADAC are not responsible for the loss or damage to any dog or possession of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. ◆ It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. ◆ It is a requirement of the club and the facility that <u>dogs be on leash at all times except in designated off-leash areas.</u> Owners must clean up after their dogs or they may be barred from further trials. ◆ Illegal use of drugs and/or alcohol on trial grounds is strictly forbidden. ◆ Only crates, not x-pens, are allowed inside the arena in designated areas. A single row of chairs ringside will be permitted.

As used here ZAP means Zooming Agility Pups Club its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents. 1.2 Exhibitor/owner agrees to abide by the rule and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event. 1.3 Exhibitor/owner certifies that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property and that the enter dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirements of the state in which the dog resides. 1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledges all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures (or lack thereof), electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking area, show grounds, and the presence of unfamiliar animals or people.
